PE days are Wednesday and Thursday. Reading books are changed on Mondays. Homework is issued on Fridays and handed in on Wednesdays. Spellings are issued on Fridays and tested the following Friday. Your child will also bring a class reader home at the start of term to be returned at the end of term

Topic

Our History topic for this term is called 'Flight'. We will be finding out about developments in aviation, using photographs and timelines to help develop our understanding. We will learn about the first balloon flight and find out about the development of gliders. We will also compare modern day aeroplanes with the Wright Brothers Flyer. In Design Technology we will be designing and making a windmill. PSHE will focus on 'Being Me'. In computing we will be learning about coding and safe use of the internet. Our RE topic is 'What do Christians believe God is like?', together with consideration of our Christian values. Science work will focus on 'Plants' using our new science scheme with lots of experiments and investigations about what plants need to grow, how they grow and labelling parts of a plant. In PE we will be focussing on gymnastics and games.

Our Value for this month is Friendship

Maths

Our maths will build on the children's knowledge and consolidate understanding of the number system, recognising and using number, knowing about 1 more and 1 less, basic addition and subtraction and place value together with mental maths and problem solving skills. We will be working practically and pictorially moving towards abstract recording

English

Our literacy will be taught through our topic book and a specific reading, handwriting and phonics session each day will support this. We will be getting to know the characters in this book and using it to write our own adventure stories. We will also use our knowledge of The Wright Brothers to plan and write an information text. In poetry we will look at the poem 'Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star' and other versions of this. Your child will bring home a scheme book book/s each week that will be matched to their phonic ability together with a library book of your child's choice. We will focus on the year 1 spelling and grammar rules and begin to develop the ability to construct clear sentences. Handwriting will build on the work done in Reception and from now on be in a joined style

Homework

Weekly homework will be reading, spellings (there will be a letter in the children's book bag to explain our spelling system) and children will also have a Maths and an English homework book that will be given out on Fridays with a page reference, I will send an additional letter about this. In addition, I will set a monthly writing task to be completed at home.
