### Maths

In Year 3, the children concentrate on the x2,x5,x10.x3.x4 and x8 tables in preparation for the times tables test at the end of Year 4. The more practice they get now the more enabled they will be when they complete the test. The children will be asked to practise their target times tables regularly as part of their homework. Your help with this at home would be appreciated.

Our maths focus for terms 1 and 2 are place value (3 digit numbers) and the four operations. The children will make links with their learning in Year 2 by building upon the jottings they made to include 3 digit numbers and multiplying a 2 digit number by a single digit.
