Maths

Last term, the children worked extremely hard on developing their maths skills by adding and subtracting up to 2, 3 digit numbers including regrouping. This term we will be focusing on multiplication and division. The below pictures is an example of how you could practice multiplication at home. The place value counters could be substituted for 10ps and 1ps. A jotting could also be drawn by drawing 10s and 1s. The example shows 3×23 by partitioning into 3 lots of 20 and 3 lots of 3.
