Welcome

Dates and Things to Remember

On Wednesday 5th October, Year 5 will be going on a day trip to Everdon. More information will be sent nearer the time.

Topic

This term our class topic will be based around the theme of Ancient Egyptians. The topic will be introduced on our Wow Day on *Tuesday 13th September*. Children may come to school in messy clothes for this day.

Through a thematic approach the children will make links between many of their subjects over the term, incorporating work through literacy, history, geography and art.

Maths

In maths this term we will focus on place value as well as extending our understanding and use of formal written methods for addition and subtraction. We will continue to maintain our rapid recall of multiplication tables from Year 4 as well as corresponding division facts. The children did a great job with their times tables last year, in Year 5 we will continue to refresh and build on the children's knowledge.

English

Writing genres this term are myths along with recounts for different audiences.

It remains extremely important that your child is reading regularly at home. Please ensure that your child has the opportunity to read a range of texts both independently as well as with an adult to encourage confidence, progression and most importantly, a love of reading. As part of their homework in Year 5, children need to read at least twice a week with an adult at home. Please initial reading records, these will be collected each Tuesday. In addition, children will be set a reading comprehension task each week. This should be completed and handed in on Tuesday with their maths and SPaG homework.

Homework

Homework will be set on a Thursday and should be handed in by the following Tuesday. A weekly spelling test will take place on Thursday mornings. Times tables (now including division facts) will be tested on Wednesdays. Our class book this term is There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom by Louis Sacher.
