Overall Aim
Attainment outcomes at end of 2021/22 for all year groups will be at least in line with those at the point of lockdown in March 2020.

Barriers to Attainment	
1.	Gaps in learning for Maths - full coverage of the curriculum has not always been possible due to illness, absence and lockdown
2.	Application of phonics skills to decode words and build up words in writing. Not all children have had a consistent support with phonics during lockdown
3.	The application of reading comprehension skills – some children have not had a consistent approach to this during lockdown and periods of illness.
4.	Low attendance, self-esteem, confidence, friendship issues.
5.	SEND children have not always had consistent access to specific programmes to support their learning and address needs.
6.	Not all children have had consistent support with writing when completing home learning and have developed bad habits with handwriting, spelling and sentence structure

Intended Actions	
a)	Whole Class sessions/Group sessions with Family support Worker/ individual Time to Talk sessions to support mental health, wellbeing and social skills development.
b)	Staff training in using effective teacher assessment techniques to pinpoint gaps in learning and supporting mental health.
b)	Extra group support led by teachers and support staff to plug gaps in core learning. Question Level Analysis from termly tests used to guide sessions
c)	Tutoring for disadvantaged children in Year 5 and 6 in order to support Maths and Reading.
d)	Extra staff to ensure daily phonics groups target gaps in learning.
e)	Increase SEND support to accelerate progress within individual programmes for children with specific needs
