Instrument of Government: West Haddon Endowed C of E Primary School

- **1.** The name of the school is West Haddon Endowed Church of England Primary School.
- **2.** The school is a voluntary controlled school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is 'The governing body of West Haddon Endowed Church of England Primary School'.
- **4.** The governing body shall consist of 15 governors, comprising:
 - a. 5 parent governors
 - b. 1 LEA governor
 - c. 3 staff governors
 - d. 3 community governors
 - e. 3 foundation governors
- 5. The foundation governors shall be appointed by the Diocesan Board of Education, Peterborough, one of whom shall be the Vicar or Curate of West Haddon should they be willing to serve.
- 6. Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, which includes respecting other faiths, and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.
 - The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
- 7. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1st September 2004
- **8.** This instrument was made by order of Northamptonshire Local Education Authority on 31st August 2004.
- **9.** A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to Peterborough Diocese Board of Education.
