RETURN TO SCHOOL

We are excited to welcome all children back to school on Monday 8th March! We are currently in the process of completing the organisation for this return to ensure that all amended Government guidelines are in place and the children have a smooth transition back into school. We would like children to return to school in their normal school uniform and have their resources with them for their first day. Please could you ensure that your child returns any school books and resources on their first day back.

The one-way system around the school that has been in place since last September will continue to operate in the same way, along with the requirement to gel on entry to school. Face masks are also still required for all adults on the school site unless there is a medical exemption. We are in the process of liaising with Kingswood, our Hot Meal provider, and hoping that a hot lunch offer can be provided each day. Kingswood are likely to be in touch over the coming days – if you want a hot meal, please respond promptly to their order system.

We will update you with further information via ParentPay, as soon as we have clarified some of the finer details.

Nursery	8.45am – 3.30pm
Reception	8.45 for 9am start – 3.30pm
Year 1 and 2	8.45 for 9am start – 3.30pm
Years 3 and 4	8.30 for 8.45am start – 3.15pm
Years 5 and 6	8.30 for 8.45am start – 3.15pm

Please ensure your child/children are in school on time each day.

We have tweaked the timings from the autumn term to remove the waiting time for families with children in more than one bubble. Adults who come onto the school site will be expected to drop the children and go straight away.

As with the autumn term, we would like children in Years 4, 5 and 6 to come onto the school site on their own if at all possible – this encourages independence and reduces the number of adults on the school site.
