ATTENDANCE

As most of you are aware, the Government has informed parents that school attendance from September is statutory. I would like to thank you all for supporting the school with this - we have had excellent attendance figures so far this term. The DFE has told all schools that is is expecting them to provide learning for children who cannot attend due to quarantine and isolation regulations. This will enable our children to continue their learning whilst at home. For Key Stage 2 children learning is being uploaded on to Google Classroom and children are expected to continue with their lessons unless they are too ill to do so. For Key Stage 1 and Reception class, we ask that parents make contact with their child's teacher so that they can continue with key learning – this will be in the form of spellings, reading, Purple Mash work as well as other activities that will support the learning for the week.

As mentioned in our Newsletter last week, I ask that all parents provide precise reasons for absence so that we can take the appropriate action and support you and your child accordingly. Should there be isolation/quarantine and children do not complete work, the school reserves the right to record this absence as unauthorised. This may seem harsh, but the children have missed a significant amount of school already during 2020 and we need to keep learning as consistant as possible over the forthcoming months.

Children are to wear school uniform for clubs before and after school but can change footwear and they should arrive and leave via the hall entrance not the office entrance. Thank you.
