COVID Update

On Tuesday the last of the daily briefings was completed with Boris announcing the lifting a number of restrictions. One of the key announcements was the one metre plus rule which can only be in place if there are mitigations. Since then schools have waited for further guidance from the DFE so that we know the implications of this on schools. To date, there has been no further guidance on this or the process for re-opening schools in September. We will therefore assume that our current procedures and measures should remain in place until the end of this term which ends on Thursday 16th July.

As the DFE has not published further guidance for September we will plan to open on Friday 4th September for all classes, although the likelihood is that there will be plenty of hand washing; a staggered school day and possibly the continuation of a half day on a Friday. I am really sorry that I cannot be more definite at this late stage, but rest assured, we will let you know as soon as the guidance is released from the DFE.
