Penalty Notices

Historically, the Local Authority has issued fixed penalty notices for more than 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence in any school term. There has been a period of time over the last half term where this system was put on hold due to COVID but as the government has clarified that all schools should continue to remain open, the system for unauthorised absence has been reinstated.

Children who are unable to attend school due to self-isolation and or a positive test will be coded as COVID related and therefore will not be classed as unauthorised. It is therefore crucial that you give a precise reason for your child's absence otherwise your child's absence may be recorded as unauthorised.

If you believe your child is classed as clinically extremely vulnerable, please contact the school office so that we can support your family and correctly code any absence from school.
