# Things to remember!

**Water bottles –** Ensure all water bottles are named.

**PE Kits** – Ensure your child has both indoor and outdoor PE kits that are clearly named.

### **Weekend Books**

This term we would like the children to write independently in their weekend books using their phonic knowledge. They should attempt to spell the words that they want to write without copying or being told how to spell them. Please encourage them to stretch the words and write down the sounds that they hear.

### **Maths**

Over the course of the term the children will be using their knowledge of numbers to:

- Solve simple addition and subtraction calculations
- Identify number bonds to 5
- Counting backwards from 20
- Number facts to 10
- Creating patterns
- Recognising numbers to 20.
- Forming numbers correctly

They will continue to learn about 2D and 3D shapes including their properties.
