Literacy

The children will continue to learn their phonic sounds and use these to blend and segment words in order to read and write. They will continue to learn how to form their letters correctly as well as exploring different stories linked to our topic.

The children will take part in a variety of learning tasks:

Reading new words
Fact sheets
Instruction writing
Writing labels
Asking questions

Topic

Our topic for this term is Woodland Wonders. We will be answering the questions – Who lives in a deep dark wood? What type of animals live in the woodland? Why are trees important?

We will be learning about the artist Van Gough and creating pictures based on his painting of the sunflower.

Towards the end of the term we will be learning about the festival of Easter and the children will be participating in a range of linked activities.

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Over the course of the term the children will continue to use their knowledge of numbers to:

- Solve simple addition and subtraction calculations
- Identify number bonds to 10
- Counting in 2's
- Comparing weight
- Creating patterens
- Place value
- Recognising numbers to 20.

They will also continue learning more about 2D and 3D shapes including being able to describe the properties.
