Literacy

The children will continue to learn their phonic sounds and use these to blend and segment words in order to read and write. They will continue to learn how to form their letters correctly as well as exploring different stories linked to our topic.

Super Daisy by Kes Gray

The children will take part in a variety of learning tasks:

Making and writing New Years cards
Reading new words – Word of the week, HFW
Fact sheets
Acting out being a superhero
Asking questions
Using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
Rhyming words

Topic

Our topic for this term is Superheroes. We will be answering the question – Who are our superheroes?

We will kick start the term off by looking at ourselves as superheroes. Sharing the things that we are good at and the talents we all have.

We will be finding out who our local heroes are in the community and how they help us.

Maths

Over the course of the term the children will be using their knowledge of numbers to:

- Solve simple addition and subtraction calculations
- Identify number bonds to 5
- Identify number bonds to 10
- Comparing weight
- Creating patterns
- Place value
- Recognising numbers to 20.

They will also continue learning more about 2D and 3D shapes including being able to describe the properties.
