Welcome back, we hope you had a lovely break. It's the last term of the school year and what a busy one we have planned. Our topic this term is 'Wonders of the water'. We will be comparing different water forms, talking about different ways of travelling across water as well as discussing the importance of water. We will be having fun exploring objects that float and sink.

Literacy

This term the children will be continuing to work on developing their reading skills. They will use their phonic knowledge to read new words, high frequency words and common irregular words, as well as reading and understanding simple sentences. In writing, the children will continue to develop their writing including using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also continue to join our handwriting in preparation for Year 1.

Maths

The children will continue to build on their doubling, halving and sharing skills as well as continue to count in twos, fives and tens. We will continue building on our existing knowledge of adding and subtraction as well as consolidating subitising to 5 and number bonds to 10. The children will be participating in various activities involving understanding numbers to 10 including quick recall of one more and one less and whole - part method. The children will continue to become familiar with numbers above 10.

Making Boats

As part of our 'Wonders of the water' topic we are planning to make different types of boats and then test them out in our water tray to see which floats the best! If you have any junk model items such as small boxes, clean pots, straws, clean lids etc... please bring them in to class for the children to be creative with!
