In Design Technology, we will have lots of fun designing and making a London bus with moving wheels.

# Our Value for this month is Respect

Maths

This term in maths, the children will continue to build on and consolidate their understanding of the number system. We will work practically and pictorially to represent numbers to 100, partition two digit numbers as well as compare and order numbers. We will also focus on adding and subtracting using Numicon, pictures and number lines to support the children's understanding. The children will also develop their problem solving and reasoning skills by working practically. The times tables we will be focusing on are 2, 5, 10, 3.

### English

In English we will be using the book 'Katie in London' to inspire the children with their own writing. We will focus on continuing to develop positive attitudes and stamina for writing, with the children writing their own exciting adventure stories as well as a recount text and a poem. In handwriting sessions, we will begin by using appropriate size letters and continue using leading lines. We will focus on a new spelling rule each week in our spelling sessions.
