Topic

Our topic this term is 'Katie Morag' which focuses on Geography. We will be exploring the story *Katie Morag Delivers the Mail* in order to develop our knowledge and understanding of the Isle of Coll. We will focus on identifying differences between the Isle of Coll and West Haddon in terms of human and physical features. In our topic lessons we will identify physical features such as fields, rivers, coast and hills on an aerial map. We will learn how to draw simple maps and use keys and symbols to represent physical features.

Maths

We will be focusing on developing our understanding of 2D and 3D shapes before moving on to learning about fractions!

We will also continue to develop our fluency in addition and subtraction, focusing on:

- Adding 1 digit to a 2 digit number
- Subtracting 1 digit from a 2 digit number
- Adding two 2 digit numbers
- Subtracting two digit numbers

We will use the story *Katie Morag Delivers the Mail* to inspire us this term. We will use our knowledge and understanding of West Haddon and the Isle of Coll to write an information text. We will also be exploring traditional tales and write our own exciting stories!
