<u>Maths</u>

When the children are handling money at home (both notes and coins), encourage them to add up how much they have by starting with the largest denomimation first. Then ask them to write down how much they have in pounds and pence explaining the relevance of the decimal point.

Please remember to keep reciting and asking questions in and out of order on the 2,3,4,5, 8 and 10 times tables and then the associated division facts.

English
