### Maths

In maths this term we will be covering geometry, measures including mass, capacity and volume. We will also look at analogue and digital time as well as looking at 24-hour clocks and learning to be able to interpret timetables and related problems.

We will continue to use our written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will continue to practise rapid recall of multiplication tables which is extremely important and supports children with a solid foundation and fluency in maths.
