Please ensure that your child has the opportunity to read a range of texts both independently as well as with an adult to encourage confidence, progression and most importantly, a love of reading. In addition to their school reading books, this term the children's class book is A Bear Called Paddington by Michael Bond. The pages that your child needs to read each week will be communicated on the homework sheets. Spellings will continue with a weekly spelling test each Thursday morning and the Spelling Bee termly test will take place on Thursday 13th December.
