In our SPAG sessions, we will be working on the children's Year 4 APP targets to ensure they are confident enough to use these skills consistently in their independent writing.

Maths

This term, the children will be focussing on the units of Statistics, Properties of Shape and Position and Direction. We will also spend the last few weeks of the school year addressing any misconceptions from their asssessments. The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) test will be carried out this month on the week commencing **05/06/23!** We will send the scores for the Multiplication Check out in the children's school reports. We would appreciate it if you could support your child with learning their multiplication tables at home on a regular basis in order to help their pace of recall and accuracy. Practising online using a touchscreen in the same format as the test will be invaluable. Please ask your child to focus particularly on the questions they are finding tricky. A good website to help your children work on a touchscreen against the clock is www.timestables.co.uk/multiplication-tables-check

Homework

Children will continue to be set Maths and SPAG homework in their CGP books each week on Thursdays. This is due in the following Tuesday. Please ensure that your child is reading at home at least <u>twice</u> per week. If your child chooses to read independently, please still ensure that this is signed. Regular spelling practice will also ensure that children score well on their weekly tests each Tuesday. Please recap previous spellings from time to time to help your child retain them in their long-term memory.

Our new class book, A Bear Called Paddington by Michael Bond, will also be given out this term. Please also ensure that the children's previous class reader, *The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe* by C.S. Lewis, is returned on the first week back (5th – 9th June). Our class books are numbered to check any that are missing.
