Topic

Our WOW day for the topic will be on the 15th January and we will be creating artwork and tasting food. As part of our study of this area we will be investigating what happened to the Mayan Civilisation as there are several theories. We will be considering what lessons we could learn today from them regarding climate change. We have a session on a Friday afternoon where the children can share information from home for topic. Our school trip will be to the Pitt Rivers Museum in Oxford and is on Thursday 5th March when we will be visiting the Maya room as well as the Natural History Museum. Details to follow shortly. In science, our topic is now gravity and forces.

In RE, we will be studying Hinduism starting with a visitor to talk to the children on Wednesday 8th January.

When reading with your child, please fill in the Reading Record book or your child can fill it in if reading independently. We will continue to check Reading Records on a Tuesday to ensure your child has read at least twice a week. Children who have not read are staying in during Thursday break-time to read.

Times tables are being set in the homework also. Times tables tests are on a Tuesday morning.
